In our view Section 98 of Standing Orders applies to this project, in addition to Standing Order 930, and therefore we have to undertake additional procedures and consultations. We would therefore be grateful if you would arrange to display the enclosed site notice in a prominent location on or adjacent to the chapel. It is important that this notice is on display by the date at the head of the notice and remains in place for a period of 28 days in a position clearly visible to the general public, and preferably from a public highway.

Also would you please arrange for a notice in the attached form to be published on the local church website

Once the site notice has been displayed and the website notice placed, we would be grateful if you would arrange for the enclosed certificate to be signed and returned to us. There is no need to wait for the 28 day consultation period to have elapsed before returning the certificate.

We enclose copy of a letter sent to Historic England for your information. Similar letters have also been sent to the Local Planning Authority and the National Amenity Societies.

You will appreciate from the above that we will not be able to approve the conservation aspects of this project for some time. We will, however, do all we can to minimise delay. The early receipt of all the information requested above will help.

We are sorry for the additional work that these procedures involve for you but this is part of the cost of retaining ecclesiastical exemption, which Conference has decided is of benefit to the Connexion as a whole. As a result of these procedures you will not need to apply to the Local Planning Authority for Listed Building Consent, although an application for Planning Permission may still be required.

Copies of this letter are being sent to the District Chair and District Property Secretary.
